

Committee for Reviewing Nominations for Master Quilter

The review committee shall consist of 5 people, at least one from the following categories:

Board Member
Master Quilter
MMQ Member.

These five may be volunteers or selected by the President in a non-prejudicial manner. If more than five have volunteered, the President selects the committee. The review committee cannot have a nominee or nominator on the committee.

Their responsibilities are as follows:

Set up a meeting place and times for the reviewers to evaluate the quilts. The nominee will bring in 3 quilts at the appointed time. Appointment time with the nominee can be flexible to meet there and the guild's schedule.

Use the "Master Quilter Rating Sheet for Nomination" and the Nomination Letter to evaluate the skills of the nominee. There must be no bias shown by the reviewer. The rating must be fair.

The entire committee meets to discuss their findings and determine what is needed on the non-acceptance letter. There must be consensus among the committee.

Completes the "Acceptance/Non-Acceptance Letter" on the nominee. These results are not given to the nominee at this time. If the nominee is not accepted, they must list suggestions to assist the nominee in improving their rating for the future.

The "Acceptance/Non-Acceptance Letter" is later mailed to the nominee and nominator(s).

A list of the accepted nominees is sent to the President before the deadline to announce qualified candidate for voting.
