

Suggestions for Master Quilter Nomination Letter

Any MMQ member can nominate another MMQ member.

The following is a suggestion of what to include in your nomination letter about the nominee. If the nominee has any of the following skills or experiences, they should be mentioned in the letter. Two typewritten pages maximum.

Different quilting techniques used by the nominee.

Mastery of one or more of these techniques.

Workmanship – the appearance of their quilts.

How do they challenge themselves to improve their skills.

Are they willing to share their knowledge with others?

Mention if their quilts have been publicly displayed.

How does the nominee meet our Mission Statement.

Service to the Guild – list contributions they have made, chairperson and committees served on, etc.
