Block 8 – Propeller Block

Cutting Instructions

Background

Center Square

(1) 2-7/8" square

(1) 1-3/4" square

Center Strip

(1) 2-7/8" x 13"

(1) 1-3/4" x 8"

Yellow - Light

HST – Corners

(2) 6" squares

(2) 3-1/2" squares

Red – Medium

HST – Corners

(2) 6" squares

(2) 3-1/2" squares

Dark Blue - Dark

Center Strip

(1) 2-7/8" x 13"

(1) 1-3/4" x 8"

Strip Set

- Using the Blue and Background strips, complete a strip.
- For 12" square, cut strip into four 2-7/8" units. Each unit should measure 5-1/4" x 2-7/8".
- For 6" square, cut strip into four 1-3/4" units. Each unit should measure 2-7/8" x 1-3/4".

Make 4 Half Square Triangles

- Pair 6" (3-1/2") squares of yellow and red fabric to make 4 HST's; press to red.
- For 12" block, square to 5-1/4"
- For 6" block, square to 2-7/8"
- Yes, those squaring numbers are correct!

Sew Block Together

- Layout block referring to diagram, sew your units together.
- 12" block should measure unfinished at 12-1/2"
- 6" block should measure unfinished at 6-1/2"
