

Little Star Points* Star Background	(1) 6-1/2" square (4) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2	(1) 3-3/4" square (4) 1-3/4" x 2-7/8"
<u>Yellow</u> - Medium Center Square	(1) 2-1/2" square	(1) 1-3/4" square
<u>Blue</u> – Medium Little Star Points*	(1) 6-1/2" square	(1) 3-3/4" square

Large Star Points**

Construct 4 Star Point Units

- Sew the blue and background little star points together following the diagram below. Press towards the blue.
- With RST, sew red large point to blue/background little start points. Press towards the red.
- For 12" block, square to 5-1/2".
- For 6" block, square to 2-7/8".
- Add star background to the left of the star point unit. Press towards background.

^{*}Little Star Point squares should be cut **twice** on the diagonal.

^{**}Large Star Point squares should be cut **once** on the diagonal.

Construct the Block

• You will need 4 star units and one yellow center square. Layout according to the diagram below:

Unit 1 Unit 4

- Numbers (Units 1-4) represent the order to sew the block together.
- Sew Yellow Center Square to Unit 1 by sewing a partial seam (approximately 1/2 way down). Press towards Center Square
- Sew Unit 2 to Unit 1/Center Square. Press towards Center Square.
- Sew Unit 3 to Unit 2/Center Square. Press towards Center Square.
- Sew Unit 4 to Unit 3/Center Square. Press towards Center Square.
- Complete sewing partial seam and press towards Center Square.
- 12" block should measure unfinished at 12-1/2"
- 6" block should measure unfinished at 6-1/2"
